The planned Alton United Junior Football hub will unnecessarily fence our open areas. They have perfectly good premises where they are now and have recently renovated parts of their club house at some expense.

The proposed connecting road across the park to the new football hub will cause noise, traffic dangers and parking congestion.

The club's licensed premises will be hired out for social events and there will then be 4 licensed premises on the park. Is this appropriate for an area the Town Council owns for recreation for the people of Alton?

Are you aware that powerful floodlighting will be erected for Alton Town Football Club alongside Anstey Lane?

This is virtually the same plan as before but adjusted to make it less obvious that this is to accommodate Alton Town Football Club so that Molson Coors can build houses or a supermarket on Anstey Road.
